

ORDINANCE NO. 2001- 09-03

AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF POINT VENTURE, TEXAS DISPENSING WITH THE OFFICE OF MARSHAL, AND CONFERRING THE DUTIES OF SAID OFFICE UPON A DULY AUTHORIZED PEACE OFFICER OF THE COUNTY; PROVIDING FOR: THE ABOLISHMENT OF THE OFFICE; AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF SUCH ABOLISHMENT; NAMING OF A PEACE OFFICER; ENTERING INTO AN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT WITH THE NAMED PEACE OFFICER'S GOVERNMENTAL ENTITY; SEVERABILITY AND PROPER NOTICE AND A MEETING

WHEREAS, Section 23.029 of the Local Government Code authorizes the governing body of a municipality operating under the general laws with a population of less than 5,000 by ordinance to abolish the office of marshal, and at the same time by such ordinance to confer the duties of said office on a municipal police officer appointed as the governing body directs or on any other peace officer of the County; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Point Venture is operating under the general laws of the State of Texas, and said Village has a population of less than five thousand (5,000) inhabitants; and

WHEREAS, the Village Council desires to abolish the office of marshal and confer the marshal's duties on a peace officer of the County.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF POINT VENTURE:

1. The office of Marshal in the Village of Point Venture is hereby abolished and dispensed with.
2. The effective date of the abolishment of the office of Marshal shall be November 12, 2001.
3. The duties of the Marshal of Point Venture are hereby conferred upon the Sheriff of the County of Travis, Texas effective as of November 12, 2001.
4. The duties conferred upon the Sheriff of Travis County shall be confirmed in the interlocal agreement to be entered into by and between the Village of Point Venture and Travis County, Texas.
5. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this Ordinance is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by the valid judgment or decree of any court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and

independent provision, and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions thereof.

6. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately from and after the date of passage.

It is hereby officially found and determined that the meeting at which this Ordinance was passed was open to the public as required and that public notice of the time, place and purpose of said meeting was given as required by the Open Meetings Act, Chapter 551 of the Texas Government Code. Notice was also provided as required by Chapter 52 of the Texas Local Government Code.
