

ORDINANCE NO. 2001-10-02

AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF POINT VENTURE, TEXAS DECLARING UNOPPOSED CANDIDATES IN THE NOVEMBER 6, 2001 GENERAL VILLAGE ELECTION ELECTED TO OFFICE; CANCELING THE ELECTION; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the general village election was called for November 6, 2001, for the purpose of electing a mayor and five council members to the Village Council; and

WHEREAS, the Village Secretary has certified in writing that there is no proposition on the ballot, that no person has made a declaration of write-in candidacy, and that each candidate on the ballot is unopposed for election to office; and

WHEREAS, under these circumstances, Subchapter C, Chapter 2, Election Code, authorizes the Village Council to declare the candidates elected to office and cancel the election;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF POINT VENTURE, TEXAS:

Section 1. The following candidates, who are unopposed in the November 6, 2001 general village election, are declared elected to office, and shall be issued certificates of election following the time the election would have been canvassed:

Terry Hickman, Mayor
Don Hestand, Council Member
Ron Hruby, Council Member
Joel Nesheim, Council Member
Jim Strong, Council Member
Ed Stuart, Council Member

Section 2. The November 6, 2001 general village election is canceled, and the Village Secretary is directed to cause a copy of this ordinance to be posted on election day at each polling place that would have been used in the election.

Section 3. It is declared to be the intent of the Village Council that the phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs, and sections of this ordinance are severable, and if any phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph, or section of this ordinance is declared invalid by the judgment or decree of a court of competent jurisdiction, the invalidity shall not affect any of the remaining phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs, or sections of this ordinance since the Village Council would have enacted them without the invalid portion.

Section 4. It is hereby officially found and determined that the meeting at which this ordinance was passed was open to the public as required and that public notice of the time, place and purpose of said meeting was given as required by the Open Meetings Act, Chapter 551 of the Texas Government Code. Notice was also provided as required by Chapter 52 of the Texas Local Government Code.
