



## **Village Dumpster Yard offers the following services:**

- **Mulch** – Much is available from chipping the brush that gets dropped off at our facility. You must load and haul the mulch yourself.
- **Item Drop-Off** – Residents can drop off brush, house hold items too large to put in the green trash can, electronics, metal, tires, household hazardous waste and “hobbyist” levels of construction debris, limited to the amount fitting into a level-sized, standard pick up bed.

### **Hours of Dumpster Yard Availability:**

Only Brush Accepted:

Monday – Friday between 8am – 2pm

All Other Items:

Wednesday between 8am – 2pm

1<sup>st</sup> Saturday of the Month 10am – 2pm

3<sup>rd</sup> Saturday of the Month 10am – 2pm

### **Drop-Off Items Accepted at Village Dumpster Yard**

**Brush** – Brush that we accept includes leaves, tree limbs, yard trimmings and Christmas trees (with decorations removed).

**Household Items too large for trash can** – Examples include:

- Mattresses
- Lawn Chairs
- Furniture
- Children’s pools
- Pet carriers
- Trash cans
- Boxes

**Electronics** – If it plugs in, we probably accept it. Examples:

- Televisions
- Computers
- Computer equipment, including keyboards and mice
- Video game consoles
- Cameras
- Mobile devices, including cell phones, smartphones, PDAs and pagers
- Printers, scanners, copiers and fax machines

**Metal** – Examples include:

- Air conditioners
- Hot water heaters
- Washers
- Dryers
- Stoves
- Refrigerators
- Microwave Ovens
- Freezers

**Tires** – Fees may apply in the future.

**Household Hazardous Waste:**

- Fluorescent bulbs
- Batteries (car and household)
- Cell phones
- Cleaners
- Automotive fluids
- Oil filters
- Paint and thinners
- Pesticides and herbicides
- Aerosol cans
- Pool chemicals
- Cooking oil
- Outdoor grill propane cylinders

- Improper disposal of household chemicals can pose a threat to health, and contaminate land, air and water supplies.
- Whenever possible, avoid purchasing such items. If you must purchase, buy in quantities for immediate use.
- Please explore alternative products that are environmentally friendly and safer
- Please transport products in their original containers. **DO NOT MIX Products**
- Place smaller items upright in sturdy containers.
- If an item leaks, pack it in a larger container and absorb spill with cat litter
- Transport chemicals in non-passenger area of vehicle
