#### Minutes

#### A. Items Opening Meeting

- Call to order Mayor Eric Love called the meeting to order at 6:31 PM
- 2. Pledge Mayor Eric Love led the Pledge of Allegiance
- 3. Invocation Mayor Eric Love
- Roll Call Vickie Knight called roll. Present were Mayor Eric Love, Mayor ProTem Lance Clinton, Councilmember Dan Olson, Councilmember Stephen Perschler, Councilmember Shelly Molina, Councilmember Don Conyer. A quorum was present.
- Consent Agenda
  - a. Approval of minutes for May 13, 2020, Special Called Council Meeting.
  - b. Approval of minutes for May 20, 2020, Council Regular Meeting and Workshop.
  - c. Approval of minutes for June 3, 2020, Special Called Meeting.

Councilmember Shelly Molina made a motion to accept consent agenda to approve minutes for May 13, May 20 and June 3, 2020, as presented. Councilmember Stephen Perschler seconded the motion. All approved. Motion carried.

#### B. Citizen's Participation

Citizen letter regarding community trash containers being removed from Community Collection Center site.

#### C. Mayor's Report

- Status update on ESD 1 & 7 fire stations
   Mayor Love deferred this report to item D for updates.
- 2. Notice June 18 will post for November 3, 2020 General Election 3 open council seats

#### D. Travis County Sheriff's Report

Councilmember Don Conyer reported Travis County Sheriff received permission to provide contract sheriff services effective June 16, 2020. Councilmember Don Conyer has requested Sheriff begin 70 hours per month contract services for Village of Point Venture.

#### **Emergency Services Report**

Greg Johnston, Deputy Emergency Management Coordinator, Travis County ESD 1, shared news that there would be free COVID-19 testing at the Lago Vista High School on June 20 and 21 from 8am to 5pm. Testing will be conducted by the Austin Texas Military Testing Team, 36th Infantry Division. Greg Johnston also reported on progress toward completion of EDS #1 and #7. A replacement contractor has been chosen and work hopefully will begin to complete both projects soon.

#### E. Public Hearings

- Hold a public hearing regarding the adoption of a Comprehensive Plan for the City, including a future land use map.
  - Mayor Eric Love opened the meeting to those who had requested to speak regarding Comprehensive Plan and future land use map.
- Hold a public hearing regarding the adoption of a Zoning Ordinance and Map for the City, to regulate residential, commercial and industrial land use within the Village of Point Venture. Mayor Eric Love opened the meeting to those who had requested to be heard regarding Zoning Ordinance and zoning map.

Citizens wishing to speak before council: Zane Cannaday, Branko Puskac, Kathie Thomas, Larry Bryan, Cristin Cecala, Gary Abbott.

Items for council consideration: inconsistent information of non-substantive nature page 6 and page 10 of Comprehensive Plan, height restriction of 20' proposed in SF-2 zoning area, side yard set back established in deed restrictions is 7.5' and not proposed 10' in SF-1 and SF-2 zoning areas.

Mayor Eric Love closed public hearing for Comprehensive Plan and Zoning Ordinance at 7:25 PM.

#### F. Items to Consider

- Discussion and possible action on engineering proposal from Haynie Consulting, Inc. for the application/installation of reclamite to Village owned roads (this is to include preparation of contract documents, advertising, bidding award, construction administration and project closeout).
  - Tim Haynie, project engineer, submitted revised proposal and estimated completion schedule. Engineering bid costs at \$11,500 and reclamite project cost approximately \$63,000. Mayor ProTem Clinton would like this road improvement project scheduled and completed now. Councilmember Dan Olson feels road improvement projects should be postponed and reevaluated in FY 2020/21 budget preparation. Councilmember Stephen Perschler requested this item be tabled at this time, revisited for FY 2020/21 and project executed October/November 2020.
- 2. Discussion regarding Lakefront Drive drainage improvement project. A bid with approximate cost of \$45,000 to mitigate Lakefront Drive water runoff situation through a private property to direct the water runoff to public right of way and public culvert was received for council consideration. Councilmember Perschler is interested in receiving additional proposals with commentary on how the proposal will mitigate this runoff concern.

June 17, 2020 2

- Discussion and take action regarding crack seal, bid received from Travis County Transportation.
  - Travis County Transportation and Natural Resources submitted bid to apply crack seal to roads within Village of Point Venture where needed. The bid received is \$14,592.15. This maintenance item was budgeted at \$3,500. Councilmember Stephen Perschler inquired if council wishes to adjust current budget to accept Travis County TNR bid of \$14,592.15. Councilmember Dan Olson requested road repairs and improvements be placed on hold for current fiscal year. Councilmember Dan Olson would like council to commit to design of road improvement plan to be implemented over multiple years. Councilmember Stephen Perschler shared he was not comfortable putting this project off for another year. Mayor ProTem made a motion to adjust current year budget for crack seal maintenance and schedule Travis County TNR at \$14,592.15 for this project. Councilmember Stephen Perschler seconded the motion. Councilmember Dan Olson opposed the motion. Ayes carried. Motion to adjust current year budget for crack seal to \$14,592.15 was approved.
- 4. Discuss and take action to approve and adopt an Ordinance amending FY 2019/20 budget. Councilmember Stephen Perschler made a motion to approve and accept budget amendment ordinance for FY 2019/20, inclusive of motion to adjust budget to allow crack seal project as stated above. Councilmember Don Conyer seconded the motion. Ayes carried. Motion passed to approve and adopt Ordinance amending FY 2019/20 budget.
- 5. Discussion and take action regarding lowering speed limit to 25 mph in Village bounds and possible installation of speed tables.
  Councilmember Stephen Perschler and Mayor ProTem requested review of speed data captured with Travis County speed sign installed presently to determine if Point Venture does indeed have a speeding issue. The Village purchased speed sign will also collect data when mounted. This data needs to be captured and reviewed by council to begin discussion regarding lowering Village streets speed limit to 25 mph.
- 6. Second and final reading, discussion and take any necessary action on an Ordinance adopting a Comprehensive Plan and future land use map for the Village of Point Venture. Will Trevino, Village attorney, introduced ordinance adopting comprehensive plan and future land use map for the Village of Point Venture, providing for severability, repealer, future land use aspirations and land use compatibility. Councilmember Stephen Perschler made a motion to adopt comprehensive plan and future use map ordinance with amendments of non-substantive nature regarding date of Village incorporation (page 6) and inconsistency in number of lots (page 10). Councilmember Don Conyer seconded the motion. All approved. Ayes carried. Ordinance adopting a comprehensive plan and future land use map was approved.
- 7. Second and final reading, discussion and take any necessary action on the adoption of a Zoning Ordinance to regulate residential, commercial and industrial land use within the Village of Point Venture.
  - Will Trevino introduced zoning ordinance dividing Village of Point Venture into several districts, single family, multi-family, commercial, agriculture and industrial with applicable regulations for each district. Current non-conforming properties are grandfathered in (exempting these properties from certain provisions affected by new zoning ordinance). Councilmember Shelly Molina requested zoning ordinance be amended to reflect side yard set back requirement to 7.5' per deed restrictions. Councilmember Stephen Perschler made a motion to adopt zoning ordinance and zoning map with amendment to establish side yard set back requirement to 7.5'. Councilmember Shelly Molina seconded the motion. In favor of motion on floor: Councilmember Dan Olson, Councilmember Stephen Perschler, Councilmember Shelly Molina. Opposed: Mayor ProTem Lance Clinton and Councilmember Don Conyer, opposed to zoning of lots as commercial. Ayes carried. Ordinance adopting zoning ordinance and map was approved.

Councilmember Shelly Molina commented that builders will be consulted regarding new single family dwelling construction for upcoming fiscal year to prepare for FY 2020/21 budget.

3. Code Enforcement

Mayor Eric Love commented that ordinances were being realigned to accept additional window fines that will be vetted by Village attorney prior to requesting council approval to implement.

4. Animal Control

Mayor ProTem reported on kennel installed as temporary holding structure for dogs at large in Point Venture and new skunk trap purchased.

5. Village Services

Mayor ProTem shared there are numerous concerns regarding parking along stretch of Lohmans Ford from Village Office to now blocked entrance to Dink Pearson park. Mayor Eric Love has contacted Travis County Sheriff Office, Travis County Parks and Wildlife and Chief Norman with Travis County ESD to inquire regarding resolution to parking along Lohmans Ford and on Village property.

6. Public Works

Councilmember Stephen Perschler had no further public works information to share. Councilmember Perschler did want to thank efforts of zoning committee and citizens for all public comments.

#### ORDINANCE NO. 2020-07-15 TO AMEND FY 2019/20 BUDGET REPLACING ORDINANCE 2019-09-01

AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF POINT VENTURE, TEXAS, AMENDING BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2019-2020, PROVIDING FOR REPEAL OF CONFLICTING ORDINANCE 2019-09-01 ADOPTING BUDGET; PROVIDING THE DETAIL OF AMENDED BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2019-20 AND EFFECTIVE DATE.

**WHEREAS,** pursuant to Chapter 102, Vernon's Texas Codes Annotated, Local Government Code, Section 102.007, municipalities may spend municipal funds only in strict compliance with the adopted budget or governing body amends the budget to meet unforeseen or unusual condition that could not have been included in original budget.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Local Government Code, Section 102, the budget officer, has presented an amended budget for the Village of Point Venture for fiscal year 2019-2020, has duly presented the amended budget to the City Council and filed copy of amended budget with Village Secretary.

## NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF POINT VENTURE:

- 1. The City Council of the Village of Point Venture hereby approved amended budget FY 2019/20 attached hereto as Exhibit "A-1", for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2019 and ending September 30, 2020 for the support, maintenance and operation of the general government of the Village of Point Venture and for the maintenance of streets and roads within the said Village.
- 2. The ordinance shall take effect and be in full force immediately upon its final passage and approval.
- 3. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this Ordinance is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by the valid judgment of decree of any court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision, and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions thereof.

It is hereby officially found and determined that the meeting at which this Ordinance was passed was open to the public as required and that public notice of the time, place and purpose of said meeting was given as required by the Open Meetings Act, Chapter 551 of the Texas Government Code. Notice was also provided as required by Chapter 52 of the Texas Local Government Code.

The legal Authority for the Planning and Zoning Commission in Texas is found in Section 211.007 of the Texas Local Government Code and Chapter 7 Section 1.1.7.5 of the Zoning Ordinance.

The Planning and Zoning Commission can be composed of five (5) to seven (7) members appointed by the City Council. Commission members serve for terms of two (2) or three (3) years with no term limits. A quorum consists of a majority of the commission's members and an affirmative vote of a majority of those present is required to pass upon pending questions.

Members not limited to citizens of Point Venture. A P&Z Commission is required in a Home Rule city. P&Z Commission must have open meetings, agenda and appropriate notice of meeting.

The Planning and Zoning Commission is an advisory Board to the Village Council on land use matters, will act as final approval for plat or re-plat request and approve all site plans with the power to include conditions they deem necessary to achieve compliance with the intent and purpose of Zoning Ordinance and Comprehensive Master Plan.

The Planning and Zoning Commission fundamental powers are:

Review and approval of all re-plat requests.

Recommend, approve or disapprove plats in accordance with Zoning Ordinance as adopted or hereafter amended.

Review, approve or disapprove site plan submittals with power to apply conditions necessary for site plan to comply with Zoning Ordinance and Comprehensive Master Plan. (see Zoning Ordinance Chapter 7 Section 1.1.7.5 Power to Amend Plans.)

Recommend amendments to the master plan for the physical development of Point Venture.

Recommend to the Village Council approval or disapproval of proposed changes in the zoning plan.

Recommend to the Village Council the amendment, extension and revision of the building code, which code shall include the minimum standards of construction for building, the minimum standards for plumbing and the minimum standards for wiring.

Meet no less than once each month, meetings to be held at Village Office unless prior notice of change of meeting place be in general circulation in the Village of Point Venture.

Planning commission to be granted all powers as outlined by civil statutes of the State of Texas

## NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF POINT VENTURE, TEXAS, THAT:

- I. The above recitals are hereby found to be true and correct and incorporated herein for all purposes.
- II. Council consideration for ordinance adoption, amendment or repeal set out in Section III of this resolution is intended as a guide to aid in passage of ordinances in the Village. Strict compliance with the procedure set out herein is not required in order for such ordinances to be considered a valid ordinance of the Village.
- III. The Village Council hereby adopts the following procedure for the passage of Ordinances:
  - 1. A proposed ordinance may be introduced by a member of Council at any regular or special meeting of the council. "Introduction" is defined as a general description of the purpose and contents of the proposed ordinance. An introduction may be defined as being a first reading.
  - 2. The Village Council may instruct Village staff to brief Council on current status of state law, and the extent to which the Council could regulate the subject at issue.
  - 3. The Council will determine if state law is sufficient or if issue requires an ordinance which is more restrictive than state law.
  - 4. If Council determines to continue the process, further discussion regarding scope and proposed language should begin. This discussion may be defined as second reading.
  - 5. After full discussion from Council regarding the proposed ordinance, the Council would direct the Village Attorney to draft a final version of the ordinance to be reviewed for adoption by the Council at their next meeting.

An ordinance must be considered for adoption at an open, public meeting.

- 6. If proposed ordinance has only correction of typographical errors, corrects cross-references, makes an address or name change, clarifies language of ordinance without changing the ordinance's effect, the council may review and adopt amended ordinance of this nature at open, public meeting with only one council seating.
- IV. This resolution shall become effective from and after its passage.
