<b>SECTION 3.</b> All resolutions of the Village of Point Venture heretofore adopted which are in conflict with the provisions of this resolution be, and the same are hereby repealed, and all Resolutions of the Village of Point Venture not in conflict with the provisions hereof shall remain in full force and effect.
