RESOLUTION NO. 2020-07-23

A RESOLUTION OF THE VILLAGE OF POINT VENTURE, TEXAS, REPEALING RESOLUTION 2017-07-01 AND PROVIDING CONSIDERATION FOR ADOPTING A FEE AND FINE SCHEDULE FOR BUILDING AND CONSTRUCTION PERMIT RELATED ACTIVITIES; PROVIDING FINDINGS OF FACT, A SAVINGS CLAUSE, SEVERABILITY, REPEALER, AND EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, from time-to-time the Village Council of the Village of Point Venture ("Village Council") finds it necessary to update the fees and fines assessed for building permitting and inspection activities in order to recover related expenses; and

WHEREAS, the Village Council finds that the fees described in Exhibit "A," attached hereto and fully incorporated herein for all purposes, will promote the welfare and safety of the Village of Point Venture and its residents;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF POINT VENTURE, TEXAS, THAT:

SECTION 1. All of the above premises are hereby found to be true and correct legislative and factual findings of the Village Council, and are hereby approved and incorporated into the body of this Resolution as if copied in their entirety.

SECTION 2. The fees and fines provided under the Building Permit Fee Schedule, attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and fully incorporated herein for all purposes, are hereby adopted and imposed.

SECTION 3. All resolutions of the Village of Point Venture heretofore adopted which are in conflict with the provisions of this resolution be, and the same are hereby repealed, and all Resolutions of the Village of Point Venture not in conflict with the provisions hereof shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 4. If any article, paragraph, subdivision, clause or provision of this Resolution, as hereby amended, be adjudged invalid or held unconstitutional for any reason, such judgment or holding shall not affect the validity of this resolution as a whole or any part or provision thereof, as amended hereby, other than the part so declared to be invalid or unconstitutional.

SECTION 5. This Resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage, and it is accordingly so resolved.

Sec. 1.01.009 General penalty for violations of code; continuing violations

Whenever in this code or in any ordinance of the city an act is prohibited or is made or declared to be unlawful or an offense or a misdemeanor or whenever in this code or such ordinance the doing of any act is required or the failure to do any act is declared to be unlawful, and no specific penalty is provided therefor, the violation of any such provision of this code or any such ordinance shall be punished by a fine of not exceeding five hundred dollars (\$500.00).

A civil penalty up to \$1,000.00 a day when it is shown that the defendant was actually notified of the provisions of this code and after receiving notice committed acts in violation of this code or failed to take action necessary for compliance with this code
