Minutes for Open Meeting

A. Items Opening Meeting

- 1. Call to order Mayor Love called the meeting to order at 12:15 p.m.
- 2. Pledge Mayor Love led the Pledge of Allegiance
- Roll Call Janice Huling called roll. Present were Mayor Eric Love, Mayor ProTem Lance Clinton, Councilmember Don Conyer, Councilmember Dan Olson, Councilmember Stephen Perschler. A quorum was present.
- 4. Approval of minutes of Closed Executive Session July 24, 2019
 Mayor Love asked if there was a motion to approve minutes for the Closed Executive
 Session on July 24, 2019. Councilmember Perschler made a motion to approve minutes as submitted. Councilmember Conyer seconded the motion. All in agreement, motion carried.

Council has approved an hourly rate of \$25 with no overtime or an offer of \$23.50 hourly with opportunity for occasional overtime. All in agreement, motion carried.
